Parent Consultations

Nursery School:

The Nursery School will be holding parent consultations on Wednesday 6th December.

This is a chance to discuss your child's progress with their keyworker and voice any worries or concerns that you might have. It is also an opportunity to talk about "next steps" in your child's learning. These will be small targets that we can work together to help your child achieve during the Spring term.

Your child's keyworker will have a list of appointments available for you to sign up to, shortly.

Up to 3s' Nursery

The Up to 3s' will be holding informal consultations on Wednesday 13^{th} December from 6 – 7.30 pm. This will be an opportunity for parents to have an informal chat with their child's keyworker, although more private consultations in a quieter location can be accommodated if needed.

As this event is close to Christmas we have decided to give it a festive theme and mulled wine and mince pies will be served while you chat to your child's keyworker, look at their special POW book or watch films and photographs of the Nursery day streamed on an ipad.

The Up to 3s' staff will be talking to you further about this on an individual basis

Additional sessions

Many parents find it useful to be able to book "oneoff" additional sessions if they have appointments or other unexpected events which come up.

We try our best to accommodate these requests but would be grateful if you could give us as much notice as possible and, at the latest, by Wednesday of the week before the session is needed. It may be that even with this notice we will be unable to provide a lunch session as our food has to be ordered well in advance.

Staff leavers and joiners

There is both good news and not so good news here.

First the not so good news – parents of children in the Up to 3s' Nursery will be sad to hear that Rachel Huffell will be leaving us in the middle of the month. Rachel has been a Nursery Nurse with us for a number of years and we will miss her commitment and expertise. Rachel has decided to take a new career path which will enable her to spend more time with her own little girl. We would like to thank her for all she has done for us and wish her well for the future.

Up to 3s' parents should already have received a letter explaining that Emma Randall will temporarily step up to the role of keyworker for Blue group until a permanent appointment is made. Emma is an experienced member of staff who has been with us for many years and we are very grateful to her for agreeing to take on this additional responsibility.

We also have two new members of staff who have joined us during the course of this term. Jasmin Cooper and Sarah Melville have started as Nursery Assistants in the Nursery School. They have settled in well and we welcome them to the team.

Finally, following a round of recent interviews, we have now appointed to the Up to 3s' Nursery Manager position. Hayley Munt will be joining us in the New Year - she is an experienced practitioner who holds an Early Years Teacher qualification and is looking forward to meeting you all in January. In the meantime, I would like to say a huge thank you to Charlotte Bedford who stepped up to the Nursery Manager role admirably when Natalie left, even though this meant a much increased work load for her. Charlotte chose not to apply for the manager post as she felt it would be prove too much at the moment alongside her university studies for her foundation degree, but we realise how lucky we are to have her as our Deputy Manager.

Application for parent governor position

We have one more parent governor position available on our governing body. This is your opportunity to have a voice in shaping the day-today and strategic direction of the school. A further important role of the governing body is to act as a critical friend to the Headteacher and Senior Management team, ensuring that the school is being run to a high standard, that levels of pupil progress are good or better and that targets set in the annual School Improvement Plan are being met.

If you are interested in this role please pop by my office for a chat and to collect an application form. The closing date for applications is Friday 8th December and if there is more than one application a voting procedure will apply

30 hour entitlement

Parents of children who are eligible for the 30 hours free entitlement, but choose to take this as 15 hours stretched over term-time and holiday periods, may not be aware that they have a portion of free entitlement time left over which would allow their child to take 2 additional sessions per week.

If you would like your child to take up these additional sessions from January, please ask in the office. The only proviso is that these have to be morning or afternoon sessions rather than breakfast, lunch or tea sessions, and the same sessions need to be taken consistently week on week.

Christmas Jumper Day

Songs Around the Tree (Nursery School)

Coincidentally, Wednesday 13th December is also the day of our Songs Around the Tree. Children, parents and keyworkers will all gather around our tree in the Nursery garden, which will be suitably decorated, to sing Christmas songs together. This will be followed by warm punch (sadly nonalcoholic) and mince pies.

Morning Songs around the tree will start at 11.15 for morning children and children in Angie and Sophie's groups

Afternoon Songs around the tree will start at 2.00 for afternoon children and children in Eve and Wendy's groups.

Parents of children who attend for the full 30 hours a week can choose which performance they come to, but please let your child's keyworker know which one you have chosen to attend.

Nursery School Parties

The Nursery School Christmas parties will take place on Wednesday 20th December (which is the last day of term). Children will take part in games, dancing, watch a children's entertainer and have a party lunch/tea. We may also have a visit from Father Christmas.

Because a 3 hour session is too long for a party, school on the 20th will start later than usual at:

- **10.00 a.m.** (for morning session children and Angie and Sophie's beginning of the week groups)
- **1:45 p.m.** (for afternoon session children and Eve and Wendy's end of the week groups and all children in Julie's group)

Please do not bring your child to Nursery until the party starts. If this presents a problem for working parents, please inform your child's key worker as soon as possible. The Nursery will make arrangements for exceptional cases. Refunds for children who normally attend a breakfast session on that day will be made in January.

We would be grateful for contributions of party food for this Christmas party. Lists will be displayed outside the office toward the end of the month. Please sign up!

Unlike Up to 3s' parties, parents of Nursery School children do not stay for this event.

Up to 3s' Nursery Party (Children under three)
