These evenings are coming up very soon now and this is a great chance to have a catch up with your child's key worker and hear about their progress in Nursery:




- Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> November for Up to 3s' children

Please try and do everything possible to make these dates, as it is really difficult when parents ask staff to make appointments in their own time!

Up to 3s' have a more informal evening this term with drinks and nibbles.

Please note that due to the costs of having to pay additional staff we are no longer able to look after children and their siblings at Parent Consultations, on either Wednesday evening.



#### **Sponsor a Planter!**

Do you have Green Fingers? Want to spend some time with your child helping them learn to look after one of the planters or

hanging baskets outside the front of Nursery? We are offering families the chance to sponsor a planter for a term. If you choose to sign up to sponsor a planter, you will have your names on a little sign in your chosen planter. We have been donated a waterbutt that has been set up outside the front of Nursery and, starting in January, we will put out a container with watering cans/basic


#### A Plea for Quiet!

Grouptimes are an important part of the day at Nursery and the only time where children are expected to sit and listen and follow an activity led by an adult.

This is vital development of their attention and listening skills, which are obviously essential for life and much needed at school. However, it is difficult for the children to sustain attention when parents are talking loudly outside group rooms. We recognise it is also really important that parents chat to each other and build relationships so would be really grateful if you could keep the conversations a little quieter to enable children to concentrate right to the end of grouptimes. Thanks so much!

#### **Christmas Jumper Day**

## Songs Around the Christmas Tree (Nursery School)



Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> December is also the day of our Songs Around the Christmas Tree. This is a relaxed and informal occasion. Children, parents and keyworkers will all

gather around our tree in the Nursery garden, which will be decorated to look all Christmassy, and sing Christmas songs together. This will be followed by warm punch (sadly non-alcoholic) and

mince pies in the main Children's Centre area, where you can enjoy activities at our Christmas Fayre (more details to follow later)

Morning Songs around the tree will start at 11.00 for morning children and children in Angie's group.

Afternoon Songs around the tree will start at 2.00 for afternoon children and children in Eve's group.

Parents of children who attend for the full 30 hours a week can choose which performance they come to, but please let your child's keyworker know which one you have chosen to attend.

#### **Nursery School Parties**

The Nursery School Christmas parties will take place on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> December (which is the last day of term). Children will take part in games, dancing, watch a



children's entertainer and have a party lunch/tea. They will also have a visit from Father Christmas.

Because a 3 hour session is too long for a party, school on the 19th will start later than usual at:

• 10.00 a.m. (for morning session children and Angie's beginning of the week group)

• 1:45 p.m. (for afternoon session children and Eve's end of the week group and all children in Julie's group and Sophie's group)

Please do not bring your child to Nursery until the party starts. If this presents a problem for working parents, please inform your child's key worker as soon as possible. The Nursery will make arrangements for exceptional cases. Refunds for children who normally attend a breakfast session on that day will be made in January.

We would be grateful for contributions of party food for the Christmas parties. Lists will be displayed outside the office toward the end of the month. Please sign up!

Unlike Up to 3s' parties, parents of Nursery School children do not stay for this event.



## Up to 3s' Christmas Celebrations

parents on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> December from 2pm-4pm. We will be putting a sign-up sheet for food contributions from parent nearer the time.


