The Nursery School works using the system of "In the Moment Planning" so applicants should have a sound knowledge of how to plan for a learning environment that sparks children's interests and leads to open-ended, child-led learning opportunities which develop imaginative and problem solving skills, rather than planning activities which are adult-led.

The position carries Keyworker responsibilities with overall responsibility for nurturing, observing and assessing the learning of a group of children, although in a free-flow setting this is a shared responsibility as well.

Applicants should be qualified to at least Level 3 in Early Years and Childcare and have at least two years experience of working as a Nursery Nurse in a setting.

This is a term-time only post for 37 hours a week, with the possibility of work during the holiday periods if desired. The working hours will be 8.30 am to 4.00 pm Monday to Friday.
