'Ditch the Dummy!'

Whilst on the subject of speech and language, many children who are talking still come to Nursery with a dummy. We know this can be a lovely comfort for children but it can be really detrimental to their speech

and language development so we ask that children

(not babies) do not have a dummy when they come to Nursery. There are many top tips for reducing and giving up dummy usage, which any of our staff would be happy to share with you. We also promote a 'Books for Dummies' scheme, where your child can bring their dummies to Nursery and exchange them for a book of their choice. Just ask your child's Keyworker!

Parent Workshops

We all know parenting isn't easy! Many of you chat to us for advice/tips about handling a range of different situations and we all know that the best outcomes for



children occur when home and Nursery work together. So for this reason we have decided to put together some of our 'top tips' and advice in the form of some 'Parent Workshops'.

Here comes the Christmas section... this will cover everything you need to know about our Christmas events and activities:



Christmas Cards

We know how much the children love to give and receive Christmas cards each year and this will still be able to happen this year, but in a slightly different way.

From Tuesday 1st December our Christmas post boxes will be placed outside the side door entrance to Nursery for the Over 3s' children and by the Up to 3s' Nursery entrance.



Children can post cards for their friends in the relevant post box and the cards will be collected each day, quarantined for 72 hours and then each batch given out to the children to take home.

Please note, to ensure children are still able to receive all their cards before the end of term, last posting dates for Christmas will be Monday 14th December



Nursery Christmas Lunch For children that normally stay

For children that normally stay for lunch, we will be having a 'Christmas Dinner' for them on Wednesday 16th December. There is nothing

extra parents or carers need to do for this. We will make the occasion special for them with decorated tables and crackers.

Wednesday 16th December is also our Christmas Jumper Day – come into Nursery wearing yours. You can make a contribution in buckets that will

Nursery School Christmas Party

The Nursery School Christmas party will take place on the morning of Friday 18th December – the last day of term.

We also believe Father Christmas may stop by and peek in through the windows to wave at the children – we have told him he can't come in to the Nursery building this year, but I'm sure he'll find a way to deliver his presents!

As you can imagine, a 3 hour session is too long for a party, so Nursery on the 18th will start later than usual that day, at **10.00 a.m**

Please do not bring your child to Nursery until 10 am when the party starts!

If this presents a problem for working parents, please inform your child's key worker as soon as possible. The Nursery will make arrangements for exceptional cases. Refunds for children who normally attend a breakfast session on that day will be made in January.
