Children often need a change of socks rather than a complete outfit change when they come in from playing in the garden and we get through them at an alarming rate.


If anyone has any outgrown socks that they could donate to our spare socks drawer, we would be very grateful. You can also help by putting extra spare socks in your child's bag.

'Ditch the Dummy!'

At Chichester Nursery School we are very skilled at supporting children who have speech and language difficulties and delays – something that is becoming more and more common in the children

we teach. We are aware that many children who are talking still come to Nursery with a dummy, which we know can be a lovely comfort for children but it can be really detrimental to their speech and language development. We therefore ask that children (not babies) do not have a dummy when they are coming to and from Nursery. There are many top tips for reducing and giving up dummy usage, which any of our staff would be happy to share with you. We also promote a 'Books for Dummies' scheme, where your child can bring their dummies to Nursery and exchange them for a book of their choice. Just ask your child's Keyworker!

Parent Workshops

We all know parenting isn't easy! Many of you chat to us for advice/tips about handling a range of different situations and we all know that the best outcomes for



children occur when home and Nursery work together. We have put together some of our 'top tips' and advice in the form of some 'Parent Workshops', which we had hoped to launch last year, but couldn't go ahead with, due to Covid.

The first of the topics we will be covering include:

Here comes the Christmas section... this will cover everything you need to know about our Christmas events and activities:




Christmas Cards

For children that normally stay for lunch, we will be having a 'Christmas Dinner' for them on Wednesday 15th December. There is nothing


extra parents or carers need to do for this. We will make the occasion special for them with decorated tables and crackers.
