
years. Sophie is going to be working for Early Help, where we know she will be fantastic in providing support for vulnerable families.

Boiler

You will recall the problems we had with our boiler in September, when despite its annual servicing in the Summer holidays and a repair that was completed the



week before it still let us down and we had to close

the Nursery! We take incidents like this very seriously, as we know how disruptive it is for families who rely on childcare. Therefore, we have decided to create a back-up system to prevent this happening again. It won't be installed until the Summer when we have our closedown week, as it involves turning the water off for a day, but will mean that next Autumn/Winter we will have an alternative system to provide us with hot water if anything goes wrong. Phew!



Foodbank Vouchers & Hygiene Bank

It is even harder than ever for families to manage the cost of living right now and we want to do everything we can to

help. We can provide **Foodbank Vouchers** if you need a bit of extra help with food – just email your child's Keyworker, message the Facebook page or catch me, Clare, or Emma.

Also don't forget our **Hygiene Bank** items, which you will find available by the front desk as you enter the building; these items are free so do take whatever you need.





Clothing Swaps

We know how quickly children grow and how expensive it can be to keep up with this, especially in the winter when extra layers and coats are

needed, so we are going to trial setting up a rail in the foyer outside Nursery where you can bring your 'too small' clothes and hopefully find some larger ones to swap them for.

Please ensure the clothes you bring are in good condition and unstained. No pants/socks/vests please. Also, if anyone has any spare children's clothes hangers we'd be grateful for donations of these to enable us to hang up the clothes.

reminders about dates, INSET days and view our Newsletter and other letters so do make sure you are using this.





'Ditch the Dummy!'

At Chichester Nursery School we are very skilled at supporting children who have speech and language difficulties and delays – something that is becoming

increasingly common in the children we teach.

We are aware that many children who are talking still come to Nursery with a dummy, which we know can be a lovely comfort for children but it can be really detrimental to their speech and language development. We therefore ask that children (not babies) do not have a dummy when they are coming to and from Nursery.

There are many top tips for reducing and giving up dummy usage, which any of our staff would be happy to share with you. We also promote a 'Books for Dummies' scheme, where your child can bring their dummies to Nursery and exchange them for a book of their choice. Just ask your child's Keyworker.

Please note, to ensure children are still able to receive all their cards before the end of term, last posting dates for Christmas will be Wednesday 14th December




Christmas Singing Around the Tree

We would be grateful for contributions of party food for the Christmas party. Lists will be displayed nearer the time. Please sign up if you can!




Up to 3s' Christmas Celebrations
