Staffing Update

There are just a few updates for you this term and none of our 'new' people are really new to us at all as they have all

worked here in one capacity or another already!

In the Up to 3s', we are pleased to welcome **Poppy Harper**, who joins us as a full time **Nursery Assistant**. Poppy was a student with us last year in Nursery School. She will be supporting Loo with Green Group.

Also in the Up to 3s', we have recently appointed **Hannah McNally** who will be covering staff to have their record keeping time. You should recognise Hannah as she has done lots of Bank Work for us already.

In Nursery School, <u>Karen Whittington</u> has returned from Maternity Leave and has moved across from the Up to 3s' to be Purple Group's Keyworker.

And <u>Hannah Smith</u> who is covering Yellow C Group for Christina's maternity leave until the end of the Autumn term is also covering Yellow D for us too.

Staff Training

At the beginning of term the whole staff team updated their Child Protection Training. We also had some thought-provoking



training on Mindfulness which we will be returning to throughout the year at Staff Meetings. We are looking at how we can all working consistently to help our children build a range of strategies for helping them to recognise and deal with a variety of emotions.

Please note that our next INSET day will be just before half term (**Friday 20th October**) where we will be refreshing our food hygiene qualification and doing session one of our Makaton Level Two Training. Our next INSET will be on **Tuesday 2**nd **January**, straight after the Christmas break, where we will have our next session of Makaton training. There will be two more INSET days in the Summer Term. The dates for these are yet to be confirmed.




Up to 3s' Places for Siblings


If you are planning on sending any younger siblings of children already in Nursery to the Up to 3s', to give yourselves the best chance of getting

Nursery Clothing

Do remember to bring jumpers, warm coats (preferably waterproof) and sturdy shoes for outdoor play as the weather turns cooler and make sure that your



child has a spare set or two of clothing in their bag each day. Also, please bring a pair of named wellies for your child (full names please, not initials, as this can get confusing for us!) – splashing in the huge puddles we get in our garden is so much fun!

As much as we encourage children to look after their belongings and put them on their peg, in a big and busy Nursery things do go astray! It would help us enormously if you can label your child's clothing and shoes. You don't need to buy fancy labels – a permanent marker or biro works just as well!

Also, please could we ask that you don't put anything in your child's bag that could be harmful if found by other children, e.g. suncream, nappy creams, food and drinks (and please ensure nothing with nuts is <u>ever</u> brought in to the Nursery). Thank you.

If your child has borrowed spare clothing or wellies, or if any Nursery toys have made their way home, please pop them in the crate that is in the foyer area and we will make sure that they find their way back into Nursery.



Parent Workshops

We know that raising a child has its challenges from time to time! From tantrums to toilet training, fussy eating and fighting sleep, it isn't

always easy! Parents and carers often come to us to ask for advice and we know it's always helpful to share problems and exchange tips with others in the same situation. This inspired us to put together some parenting workshops, where we can share ideas together and find some solutions to the difficulties that come with parenting!

The Workshop this term will be:

Please note that late payment charges will be applied to bills that are not paid on time. Do come and speak to us if you are having difficulties paying your bill.



Fruit Donations

During the session at Nursery the children enjoy fruit, water and milk as snacks.

To help us to provide healthy snacks for the children we ask if families could donate **two** pieces of fruit per week. Thank you.

Toys From Home

Many children like to bring toys from home to Nursery but we ask that children **do not** do this (even to keep in their bags!) These things easily get lost or taken by



other children and it causes a great deal of upset! This applies to children in both the Up to 3s' and Nursery School.



Sickness

It is probably a good time of year to remind everyone and inform new parents of the need for your child to remain off Nursery for 48

hours after the last episode of sickness or diarrhoea. I know this can be really difficult for working parents, but it really does help limit the spread of germs. Thank you!

Chat to Us & Parent's Evening

Your child's Keyworker always tries to give regular feedback about your child's learning and care, but this isn't always easy



when Nursery is busy. If you have something you want to chat through with your child's Keyworker or a message you want to pass on please do email your child's Keyworker and they can respond. Thank you!

On <u>Wednesday 15th November</u>, from 4pm we will be holding Parent Consultations for Nursery School. This is a time to hear about your child's progress, talk through any worries and discuss the Next Steps they are working towards. After October half term you will be able to sign up for a time slot for an appointment with your child's Keyworker. Up to 3s' Keyworkers will hold their Parent Consultations on <u>Wednesday 8th and Wednesday 15th November</u> and may have additional Consultation evenings around this time too. Information about this will be shared nearer the time.



Families Aloud!

Would you like to see the kind of things your child gets up to during their days in Nursery and get to know other parents? On **Sunday 15**th **October** you will

have the chance to come and play in Nursery with your child/children (older and younger siblings are very welcome too, as are grandparents, cousins and friends!) This is always a wonderful event and a great chance to get to know you a bit better. We hope to see lots of you there!

Chichester Festival Theatre


This half term, we will be working with the wonderful team from Chichester Festival Theatre.


This is a wonderful opportunity for the children to experience live theatre.

A message from Ruth, Executive Headteacher

It's been lovely to see the children who have returned to Nursery settle back in so well and watch the new children exploring everything Nursery has to offer!



As you will have seen from the letter that went out recently, we are soon to go through the process of Federating with Bognor Regis and Boundstone Nursery Schools (the Nursery Schools which I also oversee as Executive Head). As a group, we will be called 'The West Sussex Nursery Schools Federation' (snappy title!) This won't affect the way Chichester Nursery School runs and you probably won't be aware of it, as it is just the creation of a shared Governing Body, which will enable us to work more closely together as 3 Nursery Schools.

I do encourage you to put yourselves forward as a Parent Governor, if you feel this is something you would be interested in. Additionally, we will soon be electing 'Co-opted' Governors; these are Governors who are voted in to the Governing Body, due to having particular skills that are helpful to the Governing Body (especially HR, Finance, Marketing, Health & Safety or experience of working with vulnerable groups). If you think you have skills that you could offer, please come and speak to Clare, who can tell you a bit more.
